Damien Center receives funds specifically to support people living with HIV/AIDS through the Ryan White Care Act. As a recipient of Ryan White funds, Damien Center cannot charge a patient living with HIV/AIDS for eligible services after that person's primary health care costs exceed an annual Cap on Charges. This cap is calculated based on individual gross annual income. Once a patient has met the out-of-pocket cap on HIV-related medical expenses, Damien Center does not bill the patient cost sharing for eligible health care costs for the remainder of the calendar year ending on December 31st. The payment cap limits the amount you can be charged by Damien Center for out-of-pocket medical expenses. Expenses incurred for services not performed by Damien Center will remain your responsibility.
